

WHAT IS MATERNAL MORTALITY?

Pregnancy Associated Death (PAD)

All deaths during pregnancy and within the year following the end of pregnancy

Pregnancy Related Death (PRD)

Death of a woman while pregnant or within one year of the end of a pregnancy from any cause related to or aggravated by the pregnancy or its management

Maternal Mortality Rate (MMR)

Estimate of the number of pregnancyrelated deaths for every 100,000 live births


Maternal mortality rate expressed in per 100,000 lives




Black woman are 5 more likely to die

CALL TO ACTION

- 1.Expand Medicaid up to a year postpartum
- 2. Expand perinatal healthcare workforce
- 3.Improve mental and behavioral health screening for pregnant and postpartum people
